Each submission must be related to local government law, with a focus on Florida Law. The additional general submission guidelines are as follows:

- **Full-Length Article:** a scholarly article, between twenty-five to forty pages, providing in-depth analysis of a significant local government law topic; or
- **Short Article:** fifteen to twenty-five pages; for example, the “Last Word” by counsel of the non-prevailing party in a recently decided appellate case.
